Motion by Sorge, seconded by Pace, to adopt a resolution to allow the Otisville Area Historical Association, Inc., since there is no cost by the Village of Otisville to the Otisville Area Historical Association, Inc., to hook up to utilities from 128 E. Main St. to Lot 5 providing an easement is granted by the Township to go beneath the Township's property. If no easement is provided, the Otisville Area Historical Association, Inc. will tap into the Village of Otisville utilities. All yes, motion carried.
